We are very happy to announce that your track had a very successful inaugural season! The support we received both from the amateur racers of Colorado and the Byers community was simply overwhelming and we cannot say "Thank You" enough.

Exciting News #1

The schedule is nearly FULL! As of February 12th we have event deposits on 29 of the 31 available weekends from April 1 – October 31. In 2009 only 24 of those same weekends were rented for events, so this is a nice step forward.

Fewer tent rental expenses for the clubs! We will be erecting a 40' x 40' permanent shade shelter in the paddock. Removable canvas sides will be available during inclement weather. Plans include limited lighting and a "local" PA system for drivers meetings and music in the evenings. Big thanks to the SCCA and PCA for their commitments to help fund this awesome addition to our facility. Construction is planned for late February and will take 1-2 weeks.

The addition of a children's playground! To be located in the spectator area to the west of the paddock, plans are for a NEW outdoor swingset/play structure, with fencing/gates and a thick bed of pea gravel to keep the little fans safe. This playground will be in place before April 1st.

The planned addition of REAL BATHROOMS at HPR! The details are still being worked out, but the general plan is to purchase a trailer that has been professionally finished inside with flush toilets/urinals and sinks (sorry, no showers just yet). There will be separate women's and men's restrooms, as well as a unisex handicap accessible restroom. As I said, the exact details are being worked out but I have a high level of confidence that this will be completed early in the 2010 season.
