



High Plains Raceway Lapping Day Policies

Schedule

Summer (April 1 – October 31)

- Gates will be open no later than 7:00 am.
- Information meeting will be at 7:45 am. A second information meeting may be held at 12:45, dependent on the number of afternoon signups.
- Track will be hot from 8:00 am until 5:00 pm, with a lunch break from 12:00 until 1:00.
- Gates will be closed at 6:00 pm.
- Sessions will be determined on an “as needed” basis. We try to limit sessions as much as possible to insure the participants get the maximum amount of track time. Most often we will simply do groups of “slow” and “fast” in 30 minute sessions, but will break groups down further if safety concerns dictate.

Winter (November 1 – March 31)

- DURING WINTER HOURS CALL THE TRACK HOTLINE AT **303-769-4771** TO CHECK IF THE LAPPING DAY HAS BEEN CANCELLED DUE TO WEATHER OR LACK OF SIGNUPS.
- If less than 10 people have registered via the online signup by 12:00 NOON the day before the Lapping Day, the Lapping Day will be canceled due to lack of signups. If the Lapping Day is canceled due to lack of signups everyone who registered will receive a 100% credit towards a future lapping day.
- The recorded message will be updated periodically during the week. A final determination with regards to signups will be recorded just after 12:00 noon on the day before. A final determination with regards to weather will be made as the weather dictates, but no later than 8:00 am the day of.
- If you plan to use an existing HPR credit to pay for your lapping day please send an email to trackmanager@highplainsraceway.com so that you will be counted towards the minimum of 10 signups.
- Gates will open no later than 9:00 am.
- Information meeting will be at 9:45.
- Track will be hot from 10:00 am until 4:00 pm with no lunch break.
- Gates will be closed at 5:00 pm.
- Sessions will be determined on an “as needed” basis. We try to limit sessions as much as possible to insure the participants get the maximum amount of track time. Most often we will simply do groups of “slow” and “fast” in 30 minute sessions, but will break groups down further if safety concerns dictate.

Cost

- All prices are PER DRIVER, not per vehicle.

Summer

- For participants who register and pay in advance via online signup the cost is \$150 for a full day and \$90 for a half day.
- For participants who do not register and pay in advance the cost is \$160 for a full day and \$100 for a half day, payable at the gate via check or credit card only – no cash, please.
- Half day is either from 8:00am until 12:00, or 1:00 until 5:00

Winter

- For participants who register and pay in advance via online signup the cost is \$100 for the day
- For participants who do not register and pay in advance the cost is \$110 for the day, payable at the track via check or credit card only – no cash, please.
- No half day during winter hours

Qualifications

- **All drivers/riders with no previous track time at HPR are REQUIRED to attend the information meeting before they will be allowed on the track.**
- Drivers/riders must be 18 years of age or older. Exceptions MAY be made if a driver/rider has a valid competition license and is entered in an upcoming HPR event sanctioned by the club for which the minor holds a competition license. Please contact track management directly to discuss such exceptions.
- Drivers/riders 16-18 who do not hold a valid competition license are allowed, provided they are accompanied AT ALL TIMES on the track by an HPR approved instructor.
- At the sole discretion of HPR management, ANY drivers/riders involved in contact between vehicles are subject to being removed from the facility for the remainder of the day.
- At the sole discretion of HPR management, ANY drivers/riders who exhibit overly aggressive or otherwise unsafe behavior will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including permanent expulsion from the facility.

Technical

- While there will be no formal tech inspection required, HPR management reserves the right to inspect any vehicle and require correction of issues of concern.
- All vehicles must be in good general operating condition with acceptable tire tread depth and brake lining thickness.
- Vehicles must be free of fluid leaks and all body work and other accessories must be securely attached.
- Battery must be securely tied down.
- Anyone who enters the racing surface as a driver/rider or passenger must wear a helmet designed for car or motorcycle use.

Cars

- All loose items must be removed from the passenger compartment and trunk.
- 3 point OEM seatbelts minimum required.
- Convertibles MUST have factory installed occupant rollover protection installed directly behind the driver's seat. Windshield only rollover protection is not sufficient. Aftermarket rollover protection is acceptable subject to HPR management approval.
- Passengers are allowed, subject to restriction at the discretion of track management. Passengers must be at least 18 years of age.

Motorcycles

- Water cooled motorcycles must not use any type of glycol in the cooling system. Water and “Water Wetter” is acceptable.
- Motorcycles must have rear view mirrors either removed or covered with tape. HPR recognized instructors are exempted from this requirement.
- Motorcycle riders must wear full 1 piece or 2 piece leathers. 2 piece suits must zip all the way around at the waist.
- Boots that cover the ankle and gloves that cover the wrist are required.
- Full face helmets are required. Hinged full face helmets are not allowed.
- Passengers are NOT allowed on ANY motorcycle.

Cancelations and Credits

- **All cancelation notices MUST be emailed to trackmanager@highplainsraceway.com.** Voicemails or emails sent to other addresses will not be honored.
- If HPR cancels a Lapping Day for any reason prior to 12:00 noon, all participants will receive a 100% credit towards another regularly scheduled Lapping Day.
- If HPR cancels a Lapping Day for any reason after 12:00 noon, all participants will receive a 50% credit towards another regularly scheduled Lapping Day.
- If the participant cancels and gives at least 48 hours notice, they will receive a 100% credit towards another regularly scheduled lapping day.
- If the participant cancels and gives less than 48 hours notice, they will receive a 50% credit towards another regularly scheduled lapping day.
- “No shows” will not receive any credit, notice must be given.
- Only credits will be issued for cancelations, no refunds will be given.
- **No refunds or credits will be given for mechanical or any other reason once the vehicle has entered the racetrack.**
