



HPR Roadracing Event RULES

(Version 1.0 4/23/2020)

Before we get into a lot of detail please remember that this is just for fun and is being put together very hastily. It won't be perfect, let's just have a good time.

So, let's get to the good stuff! What will this program look like? Who can enter? What are the classes? How much does it cost?

Eligibility:

- Any rider with a valid 2018, 2019 or 2020 MRA race license and in good standing with the MRA is eligible to apply for entry. Other race licenses will be considered on a case by case basis.
- All entry applications are subject to the approval of the Race Director.
- Novice riders can ride in NOV classes only. Experts can ride in EX classes only.
- All motorcycles will be required to pass a normal MRA tech inspection.

Classes:

- (NOV) Novice GTU (same as MRA)
- (NOV) Novice GTO (same as MRA)
- (EX) Lightweight Grand Prix (MRA LWGP, Supermoto, Production Cup and Formula Colorado)
- (EX) Middleweight Superbike (Same as MRA)
- (EX) Open Superbike (same as MRA)
- (EX) SuperTwins GTU (same as MRA)
- (EX) SuperTwins GTO (same as MRA)
- Everything is SB or GP rules. Technical rules enforcement will be slim to non-existent, but don't be the guy who rides their OSB in LWGP...it'd be really embarrassing if you didn't win.

Miscellaneous:

- Procedurally (flags/lights, calls to grid, gridding/starting, etc) this will run identical to an MRA race. We're not gonna reinvent the wheel here.
- Practice groups A through D will be divided up by lap time.
- We plan on running three different course configurations (see the schedule for more info).
 - Full Course races will be 12 laps or 24 minutes, whichever comes first.
 - For alternate configurations the lap counts will increase appropriately to match the 24-minute clock.
 - If the clock runs out the checkered flag will be shown to the leader at the next pass after 24 minutes has elapsed. In this case there may or may not be a white flag displayed to the entire field.



- The 24-minute clock runs under a red flag, if a race is cut really short we will consider running it again at the end of the day if time permits.
- There will be two qualifying sessions for everyone on Saturday morning. Your best time from either session is your qualifying time.
 - If you have two bikes you will need to ride a different bike in each qualifying session and advise T/S which was which. If you have three or more bikes we'll figure it out (and you need to attend a meeting or something)
- Grids for Race 1 will be set by qualifying.
 - If you miss Friday Check In and "Late Check In" Saturday morning you will be gridded at the back of all Race 1 classes regardless of qualifying time.
- Grids for Race 2 will be set by the finish positions of Race 1 only.
- Grids for Race 3 will be set by the finish positions of Race 2 only.
- Entry Fee will be a flat rate of \$150. If we get more than 100 entries, we will refund everyone \$25. This covers both days and you can enter as many classes as you have legal bikes for, or you can ride a single bike in as many classes as it qualifies for.
 - You can ride just one day or the other, but no discounts
- Remember, no trophies, no points, no purse – just fun. Glenn Conser will be the Race Director and will handle all decisions, but if you ask me for a protest form or otherwise try to take this too seriously I **WILL** make fun of you.
